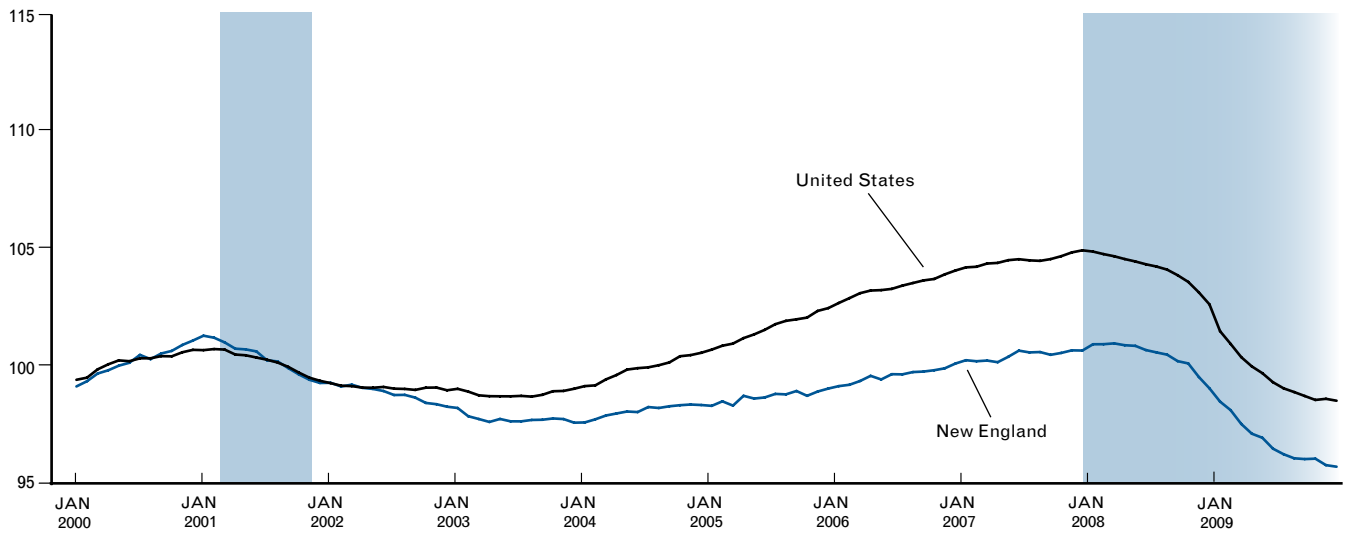

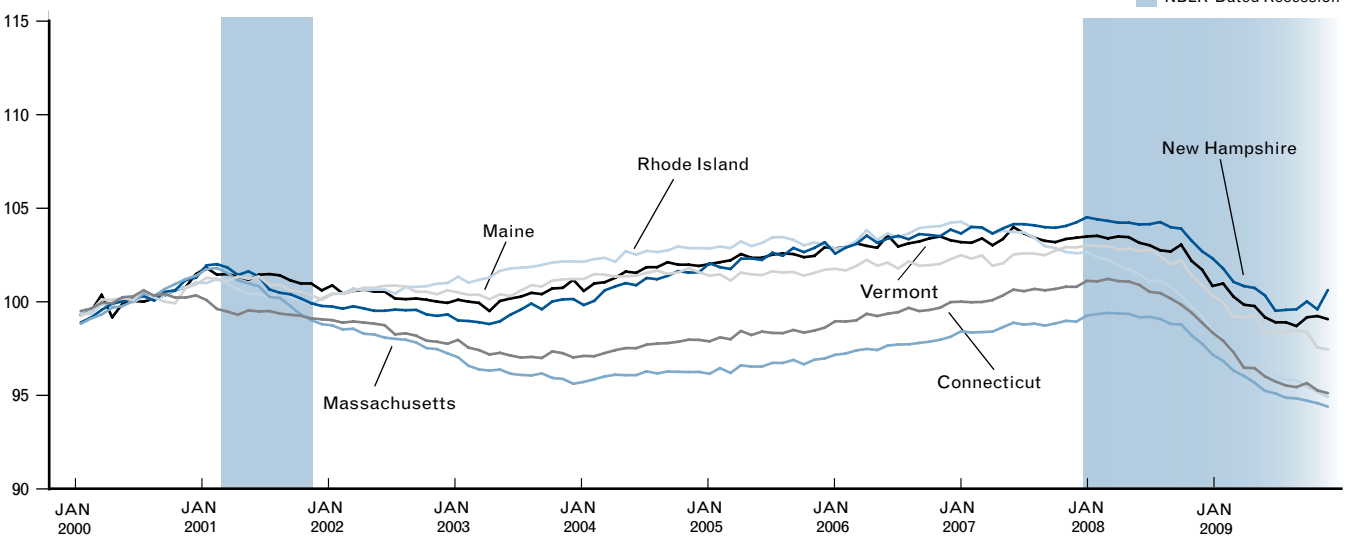
Total Nonagricultural Employment

Index: 2000 Average=100, Seasonally Adjusted



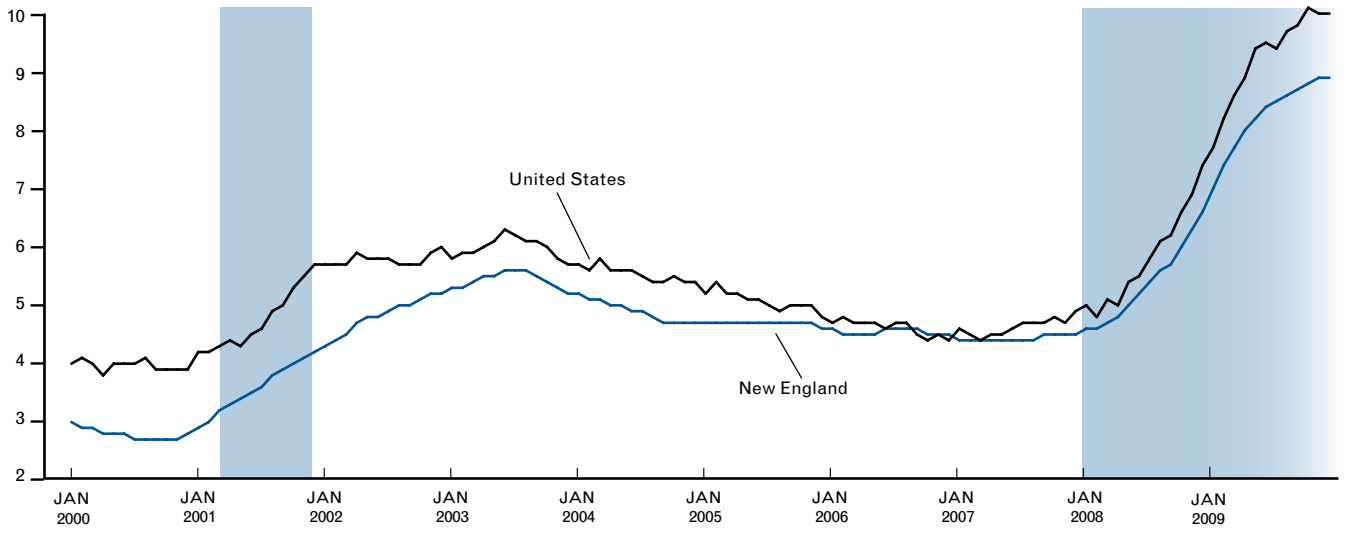
Total Nonagricultural Employment

Index: 2000 Average=100, Seasonally Adjusted



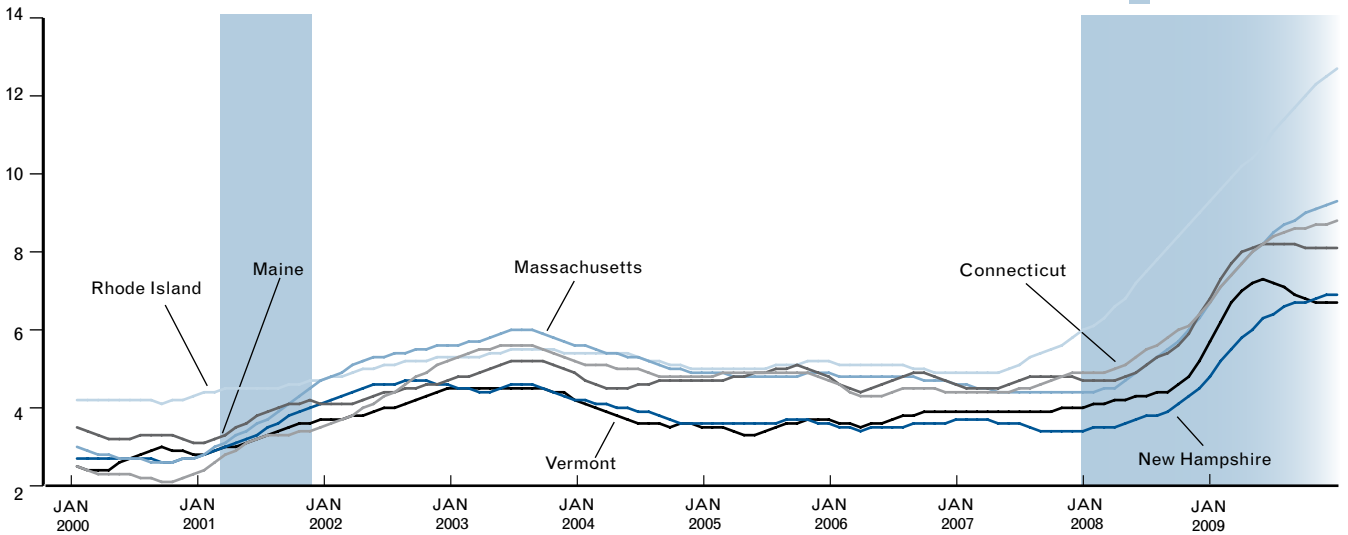
Unemployment Rate

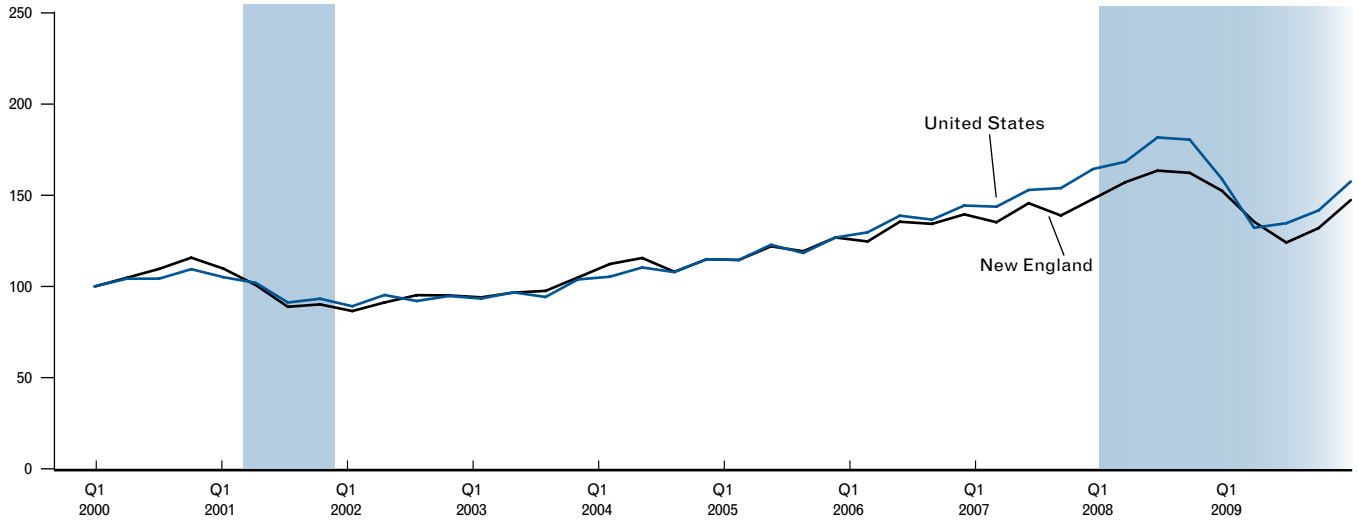

Index: Q1 2000=100, Not Seasonally Adjusted

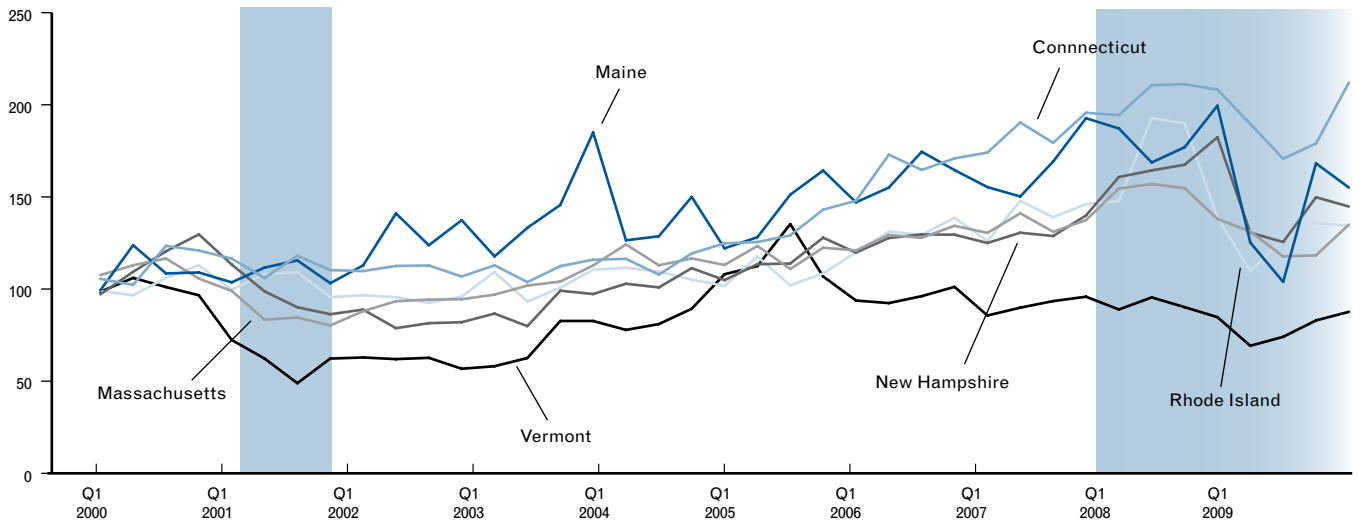

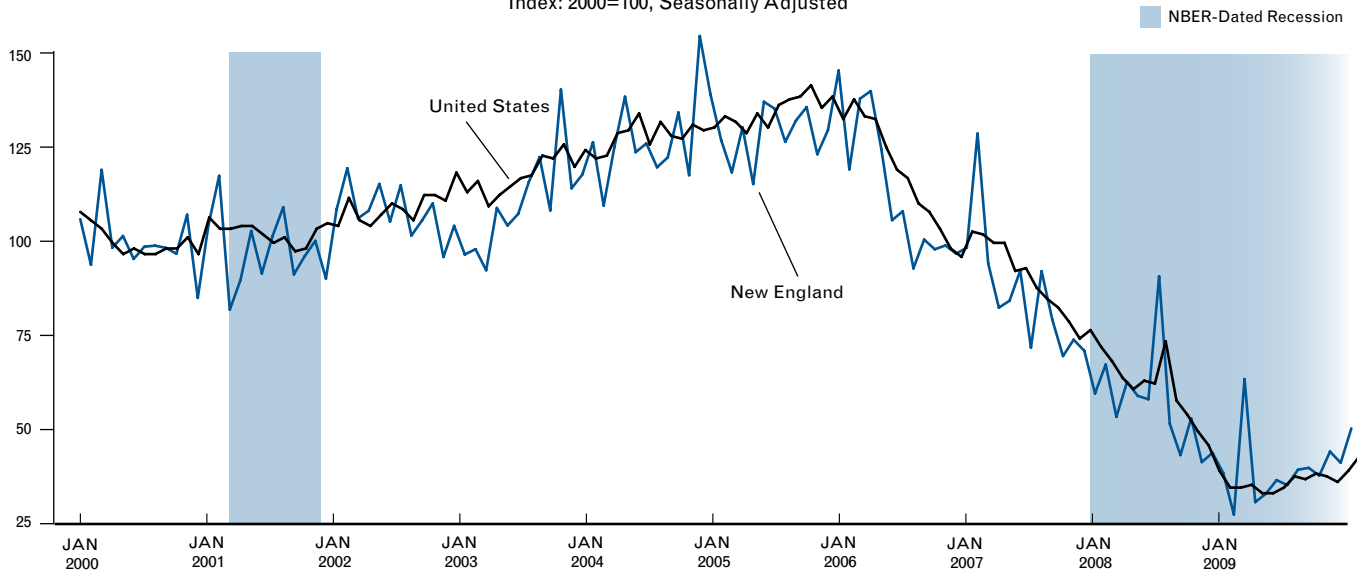

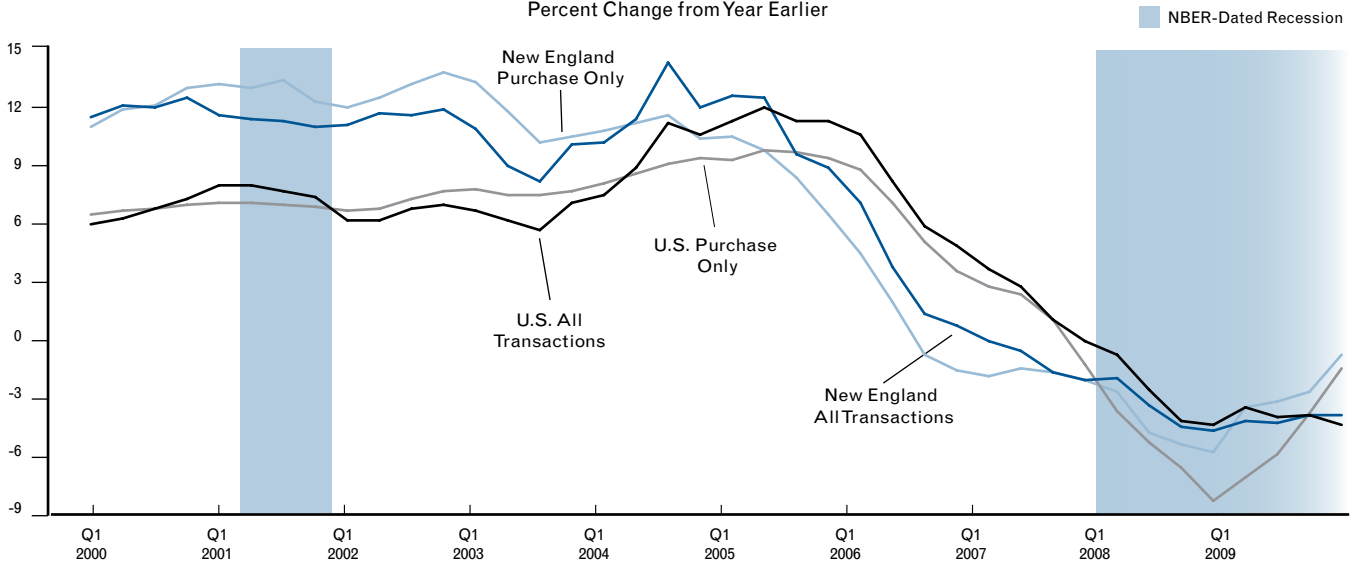
Total Housing Permits

FHFA Home Price Index

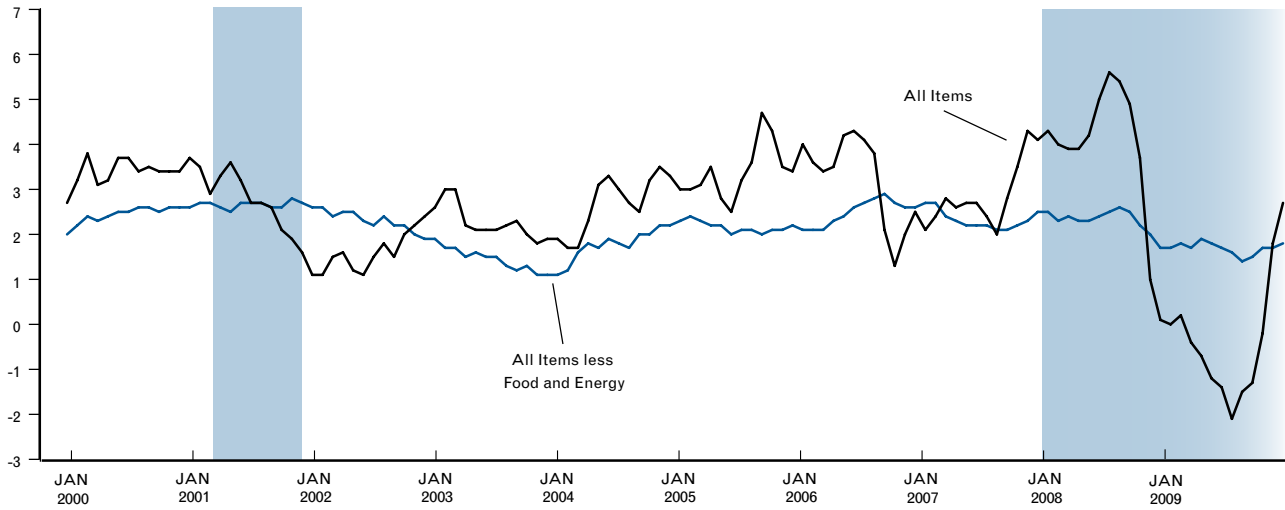
Percent Change from Year Earlier
