


### Non-agricultural Employment

#### Percent Change, September 2017 - September 2018




### **Unemployment Rates**

### Labor Force Participation Rate



## U-6 Rates





Percent Change, Q2 2017 - Q2 2018




### FHFA Purchase-Only Home Price


### Components of the Consumer Price Index



Percent Change, September 2017 - September 2018




### State Employment Growth by Industry
