
Small Business Credit Survey

The Small Business Credit Survey (SBCS) is designed to provide timely information on small business financing needs, decisions, and outcomes to policy makers, researchers, and service providers. Intelligence on small firms' financing needs and gaps is fundamental to understanding and bolstering the sector's health and growth. The information contained in this report is from employer firms who responded to the survey and indicated that their firm was headquartered in Connecticut and survey responses are weighted to represent the distribution of firms in the state the business operates in.




Number of Employees^{1,2,3}

(% of employer firms)




Age of Firm¹




Financial Challenges Experienced in Past 12 Months¹

(% of employer firms)







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
Reasons for Seeking Financing¹
