

Charles W. Bentley Jr. is the President and CEO of Colt's Plastics Co., Inc. a supplier of plastic packaging for the cosmetic, pharmaceutical, and personal care industries. Mr. Bentley has been involved in the Society of the Plastics Industry (SPI) as head of the New England Molders Division, President of the New England Region, and as a Director on the National Board. He has also been involved locally in education and was involved in the creation of the Quinebaug Valley Community College Plastics Institute. Mr. Bentley attended Hanover College and earned a BA in Business Administration. He was elected as a Board member of Putnam Bank in 2006. Mr. Bentley's involvement in manufacturing, and particularly plastics, has enabled him to develop relations within the local and surrounding industrial community.
